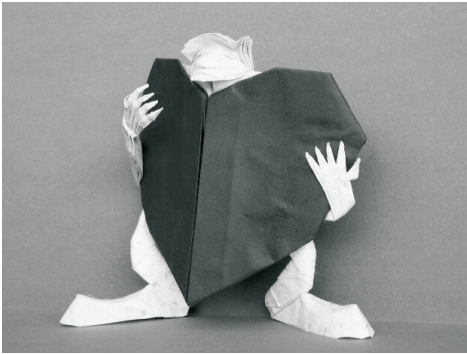


# BEATING LIFE INTO PAPER

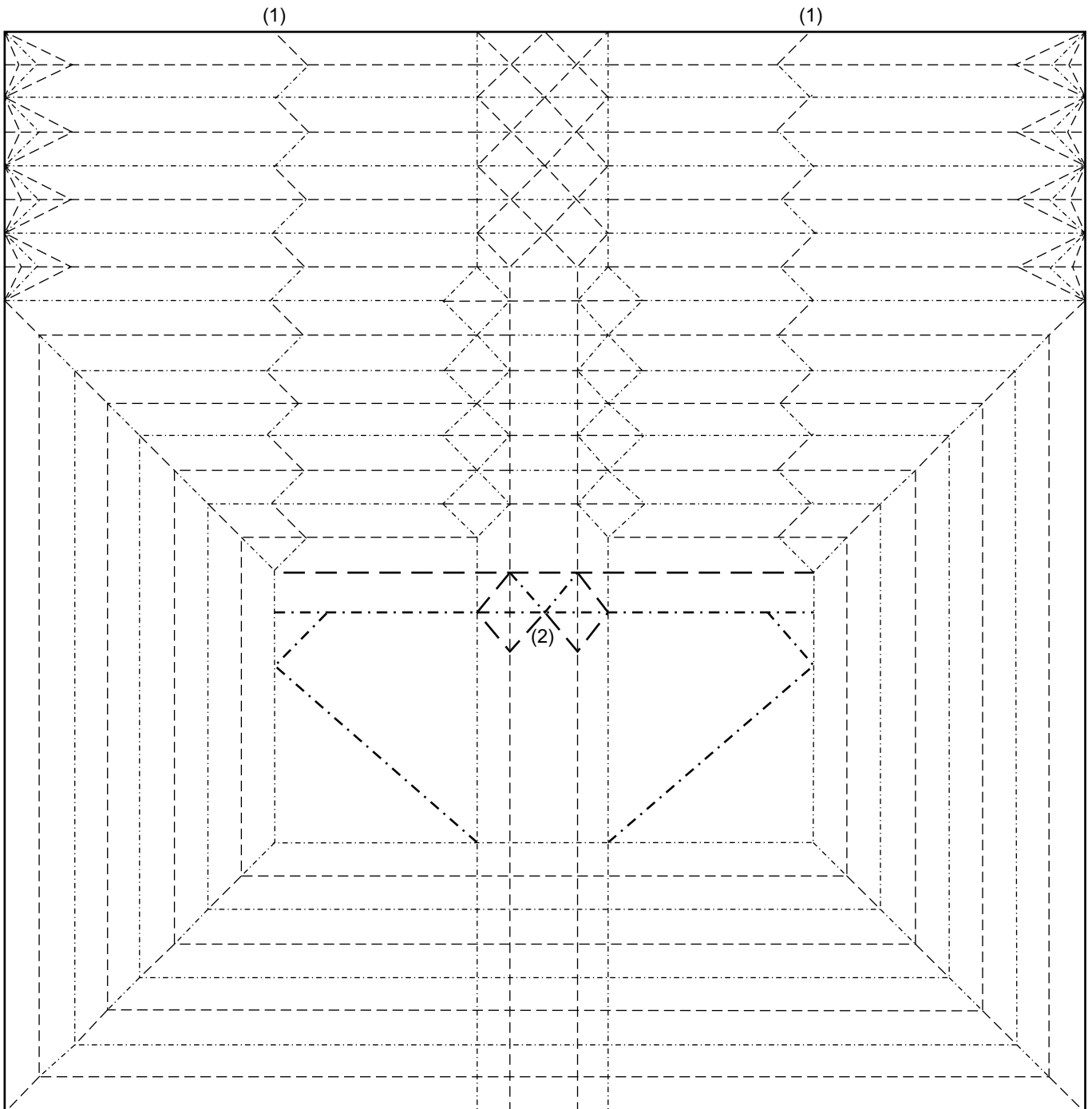

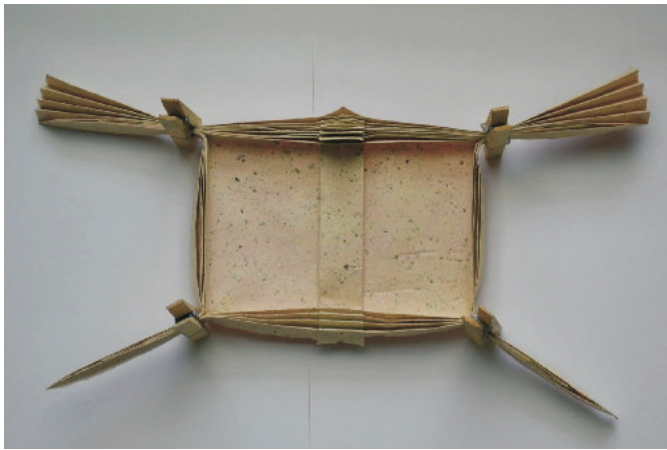
## Instructions:

- 1/ Divide the paper in a 32x32 grid (color side up)
- 2/ Fold all creases (except the bold ones)
- 3/ Collapse (see pictures 1 and 2)
- 4/ Form the heart using the bold creases (see picture 3)
- 5/ Shape to taste

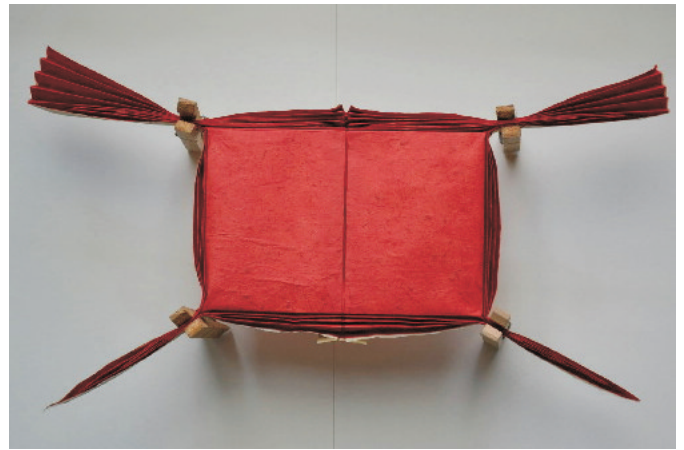


## Notes:

- (1) These creases originate when folding flat after collapsing.
- (2) These creases are needed in order to be able to open up the heart in the middle.

**Picture 2:** After the collapse (front side)

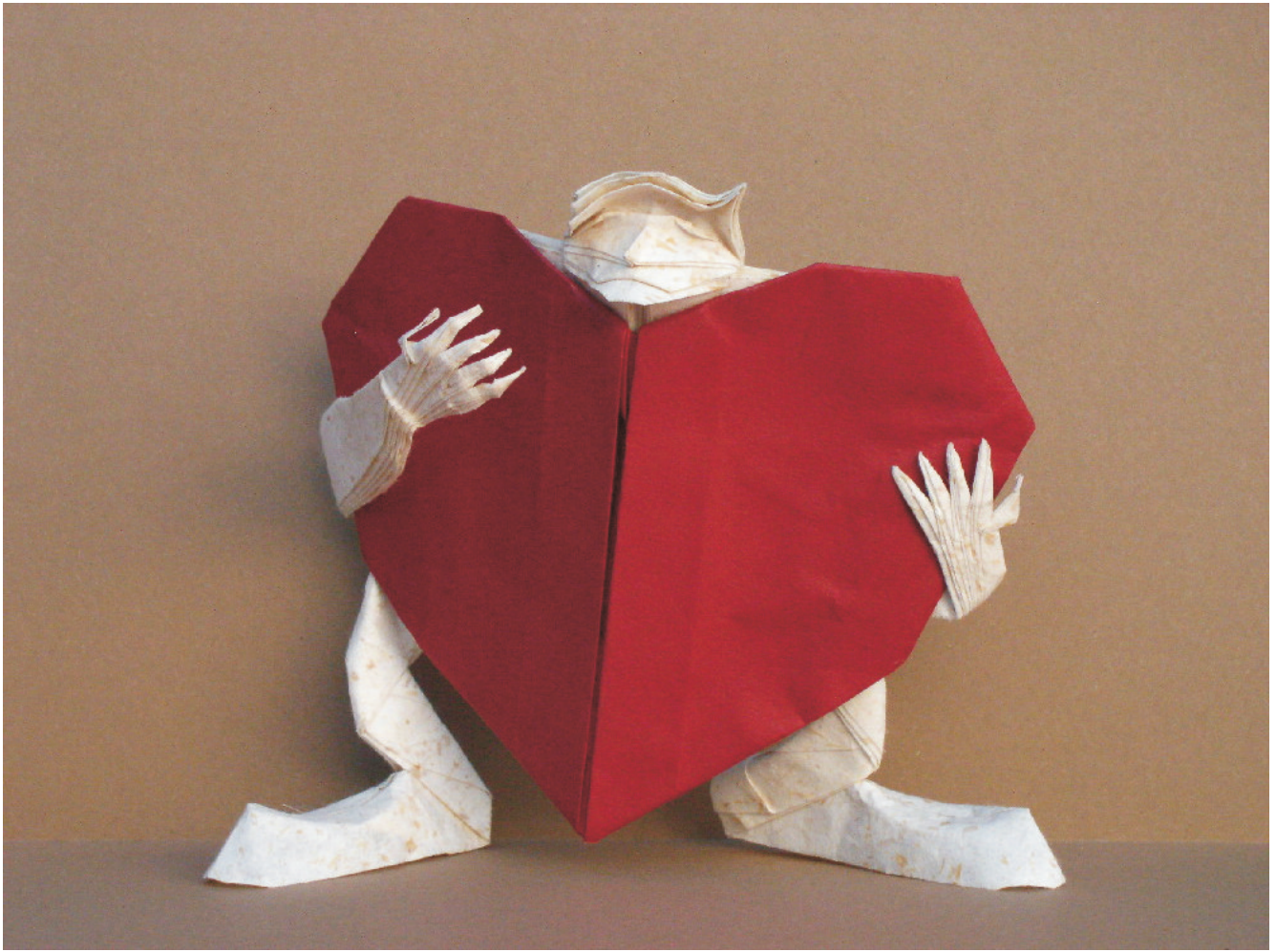


**Picture 3:** Heart and face finished.
