## Instructions:

1/ Divide the paper in a $32 \times 32$ grid (color side up) 2/ Fold all creases (except the bold ones)
3/ Collapse (see pictures 1 and 2)
4/ Form the heart using the bold creases (see picture 3) 5/ Shape to taste

Notes:
(1) These creases originate when folding flat after collapsing.
(2) These creases are needed in order to be able to open up the heart in the middle.
