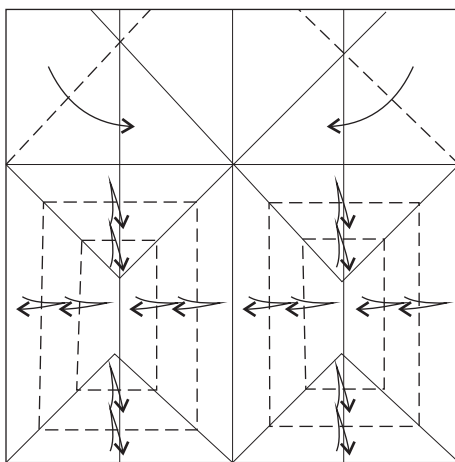
1. White side up. Precrease in 1/4ths.



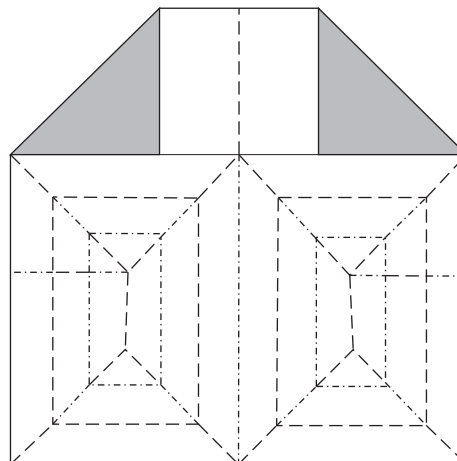
2. Precrease as indicated.



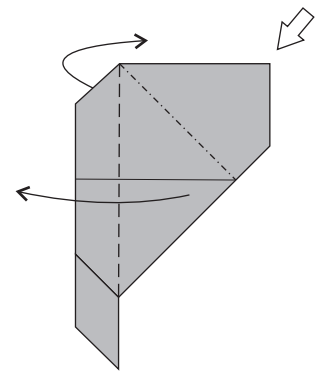
3. Precrease along the angle bisectors.



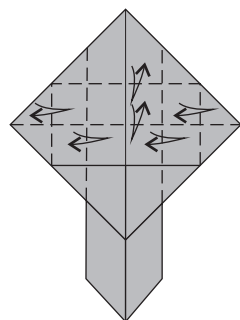
4. Precrease in 1/3ths as indicated. Valley-fold the top corners down.



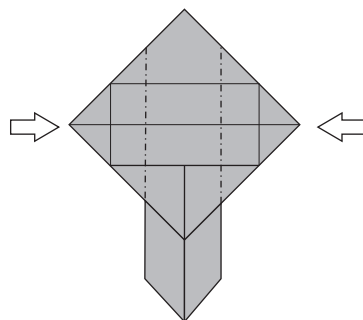
5. Collapse as indicated.



6. Squash-fold as indicated using an existing crease. Fold one layer to the right behind.



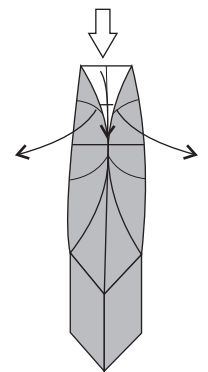
7. Precrease as indicated.



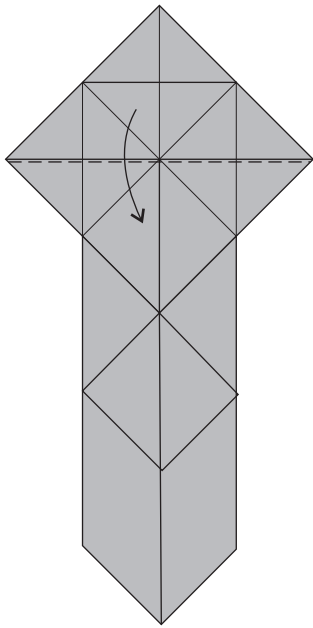
8. Reverse-fold on creases made in step 7.



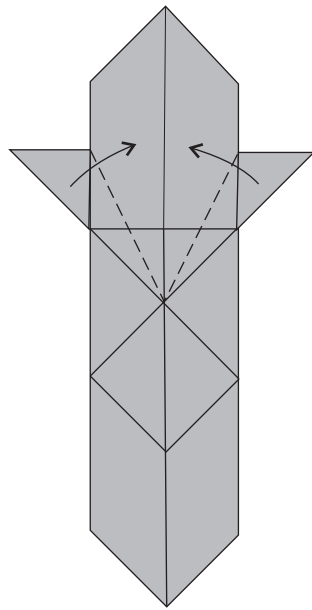
9. Valley-fold upwards using a crease made in step 7. The model will not lie flat.



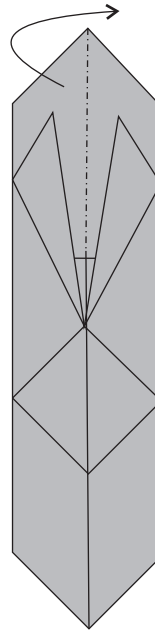
10. Squash to flatten, mostly using creases made in step 7.



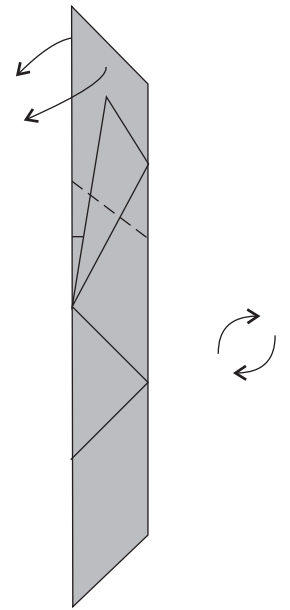
11. Valley-fold the flap down.



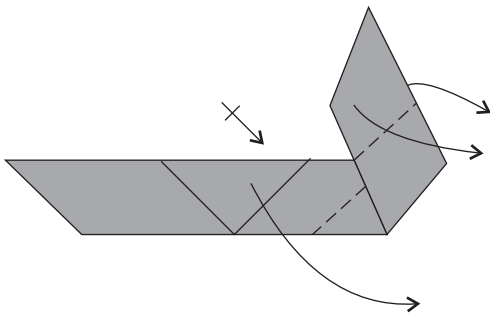
12. Valley-fold the tips as indicated.



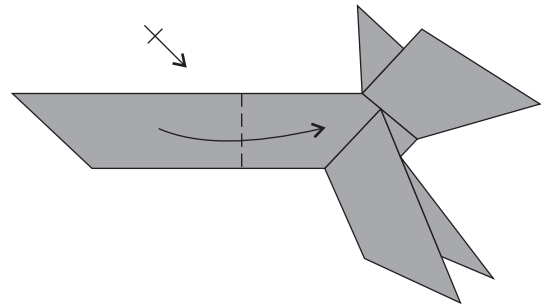
13. Fold in half.



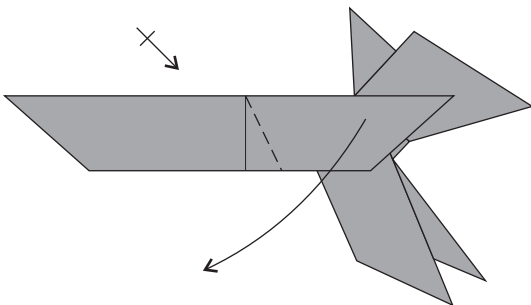
14. Outside reverse-fold. Rotate 90°.



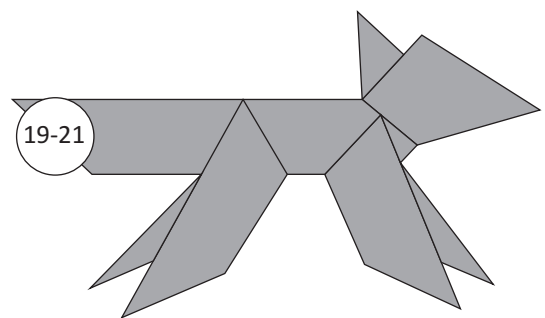
15. Outside reverse-fold the head. Valley-fold the front leg down. Repeat behind.



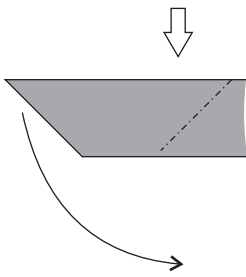
16. Valley-fold the hind leg to the right. Repeat behind.



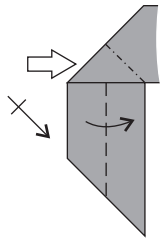
17. Valley-fold the hind leg down. Repeat behind.



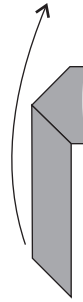
18. The model now looks like this. Steps 19-21 will focus on the tail.



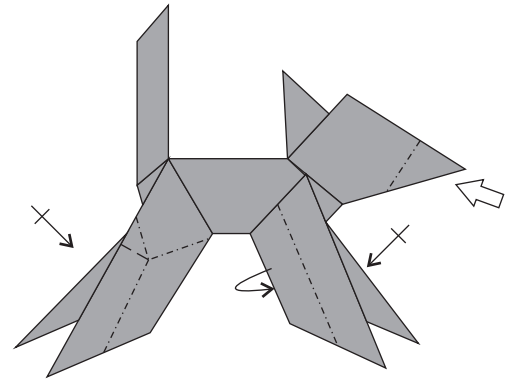
19. Detail of the tail. Reverse-fold downwards.



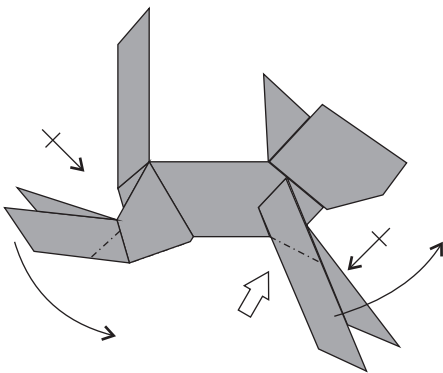
20. Fold to the edge. Reverse-fold at the top. Repeat behind.



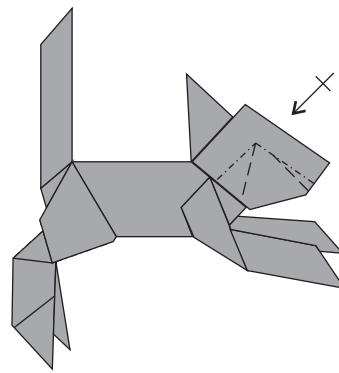
21. Fold the tail upwards.



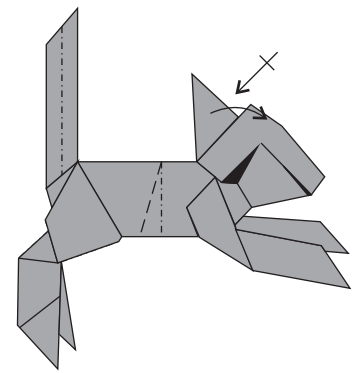
22. Rabbit-ear the hind leg. Mountain-fold the front leg. Repeat behind. Reverse-fold the tip of the head.



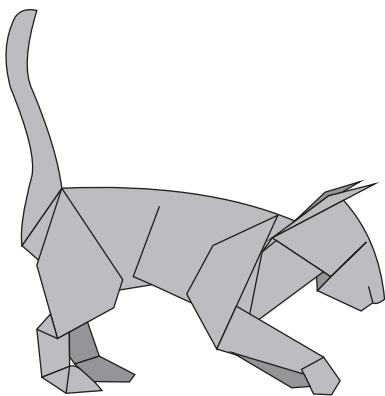
23. Mountain-fold the hind leg downwards. Reverse-fold the front leg. Repeat behind.



24. Form the head as indicated. Repeat behind.



25. Pinch the tail, crimp to curve the body and fold the ears a bit downwards. Shape legs and feet to taste.



26. Finished cat.
