

Mises Seminar Eighth Edition Sestri Levante 8-9 October 2011

Call for Papers

IBL (Istituto Bruno Leoni, <u>www.brunoleoni.it</u>) wishes to invite you to contribute a paper to the **2011 edition of the Mises Seminar**, to be held in Sestri Levante (Italy), October 8th-9th.

Submitting authors should be younger than 35 years old.

This year is the 50th anniversary of Bruno Leoni's seminal Freedom and the Law. The volume can be accessed on Liberty Fund's website at <u>http://oll.libertyfund.org/?option=com_staticxt&staticfile=show.php%3Ftitle=920</u>.

The general theme discussed in the submitted essays will be the following:

Freedom and the Law. Rules and Institutions in a Free-Market Society.

The issue can be investigated from the perspective of law, philosophy, economics, sociology, history, economic history.

The Keynote Speakers at the 8th Mises Seminar will be:

Leszek **Balcerowicz** (Former Polish Minister of Finances and former Chairman of the Polish Central Bank) Vernon L. **Smith** (Professor of Economics at Chapman University and 2002 Nobel Laureate in Economics)

Authors are invited to submit a proposal of about **500 words** in English to Dr Carlo Lottieri (<u>carlo.lot-tieri@brunoleoni.it</u>) not later than **February 28th**, **2011**.

IBL will then select the best submissions and inform the candidates accordingly by **March 30**. Conference paper (max. lenght **40,000 characters**, in English) are to be submitted to IBL by **July 1st 2011**.

All travel and boarding expenses of the selected authors will be paid for by Istituto Bruno Leoni.
